Orillia is offering this as an Open event. We will offer both distances, if needed. 3km = 27 laps and 1½ km = 13½ laps. Men and Women aged 55+ will be combined into one division. We will plan to skate the distance twice in the same session. There will be a brief warm up. All skaters will submit their predicted time in writing. Skaters will be arranged in heats depending on numbers. All skaters should be prepared to act as timers/lap counters for another skater. Differentials will be posted. Then we'll do it again. Lowest differential wins. Speed and skating prowess are not required. All skaters will be competing for their own district only.
