



John "Jack" Haines

August 5, 1947 - November 28, 2024

It is with profound sadness that the family of John (Jack) Taylor Haines announces his passing at Cornwall Hospice on Thursday November 28th, 2024 at the age of 77.

Loving husband, best friend and business partner of Lise Haines (nee Campeau). Jack is mourned by his daughters Hilary Heenan (Mike) and Lauren Haines (Jay) as well as his stepdaughter Mallory Boileau (Bobby) and stepson Nicolas Lutz. Grampa Jack leaves to mourn his amazing grandchildren Olivia, Carson, Anna, Dalila, Elise & Eve. He was extremely proud of all of them.

Jack began his working career as Media Manager at St Lawrence College in 1969 and left in 1986 to join Bendix Avelex as Plant Manager. In 1992 he started a training centre, Heritage Institute and acquired the franchise for MicroAge Computers from which he retired in 2020.

His true passion was hockey beginning in his hometown of Stratford, Ontario with the Braves then moving on to The Fredericton Red Wing. Jack then joined the Shawinigan Bruins, followed by Les Castors de Sherbrooke and the Drummondville Royals. Between 1971 and 1974, Jack coached the St Lawrence College Road Runners. Long time player for the Hubs he also played with the Ontario District 8 Morrisburg Combines bringing home the gold medal in 2018 in the 70+ division. He cherished the innumerable friendships made through hockey and was a fiercely loyal friend to the end. Modest about his accomplishments in hockey he could often be heard saying "I'm not just a pretty face, you know". In following Jack's wishes there will be no wake or funeral service. Sudbury 2025 Ontario 55+ Summer Games Update

As some members may be aware, changes have been made to the services that will be provided at the Ontario 55+ Games. Registration costs for the Games are being significantly reduced. The additional changes will include:

- Participants will directly book and pay for their own accommodations at the
 Games
 - Limited transportation to sport venues will be available from designated hotels/accommodations. Participants will be responsible for their own transportation to sport venues, if not using the Games shuttle
- Participants will be responsible for breakfasts and one dinner at the Games. The remaining one dinner and lunches will be provided by the Games Organizing Committee

The Sudbury 2025 Ontario 55+ Summer Games are scheduled to take place <u>AUGUST 5th to the 7th, 2025</u>. The Games Organizing Committee for the <u>upcoming</u> <u>summer Games</u> will be providing information about available room blocks and rates to assist with booking your accommodations. Stay tuned for this information in early 2025!

1:1 PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM

150 languages.

Caregivers can connect with trained Peer Mentor volunteers for 1:1 phone calls to receive emotional support and discuss their caregiving challenges and needs.

ONLINE SUPPORT GROUPS

An opportunity for caregivers to connect with each other in a supportive environment to share their challenges, successes, and concerns. Support groups are offered several times a week with the option to join online or by phone.

SCALE (Supporting Caregiver Awareness, Learning and Empowerment) PROGRAM

The program aims to empower caregivers with practical information and skills to focus on their own mental health and wellbeing needs by offering webinars, strategies/tools, online group/individual counselling.

CAREGIVER COACHING PROGRAM (Limited, eligibility-based service)

A professional one-to-one relationship between a Coach and a caregiver. The Coach can provide caregivers with the tools they need to meet their challenges and responsibilities. See program webpage for eligibility requirements.

EDUCATIONAL WEBINARS

Live one-hour webinars presented by subject matter experts on a variety of timely and important topics for caregivers. To register for upcoming webinars, please visit our Eventbrite page.

ONLINE LEARNING LIBRARY

OCO offers several eLearning modules aimed at building caregiver knowledge and skills. The courses are self-directed and can be accessed at any time.

90SECOND CAREGIVER


